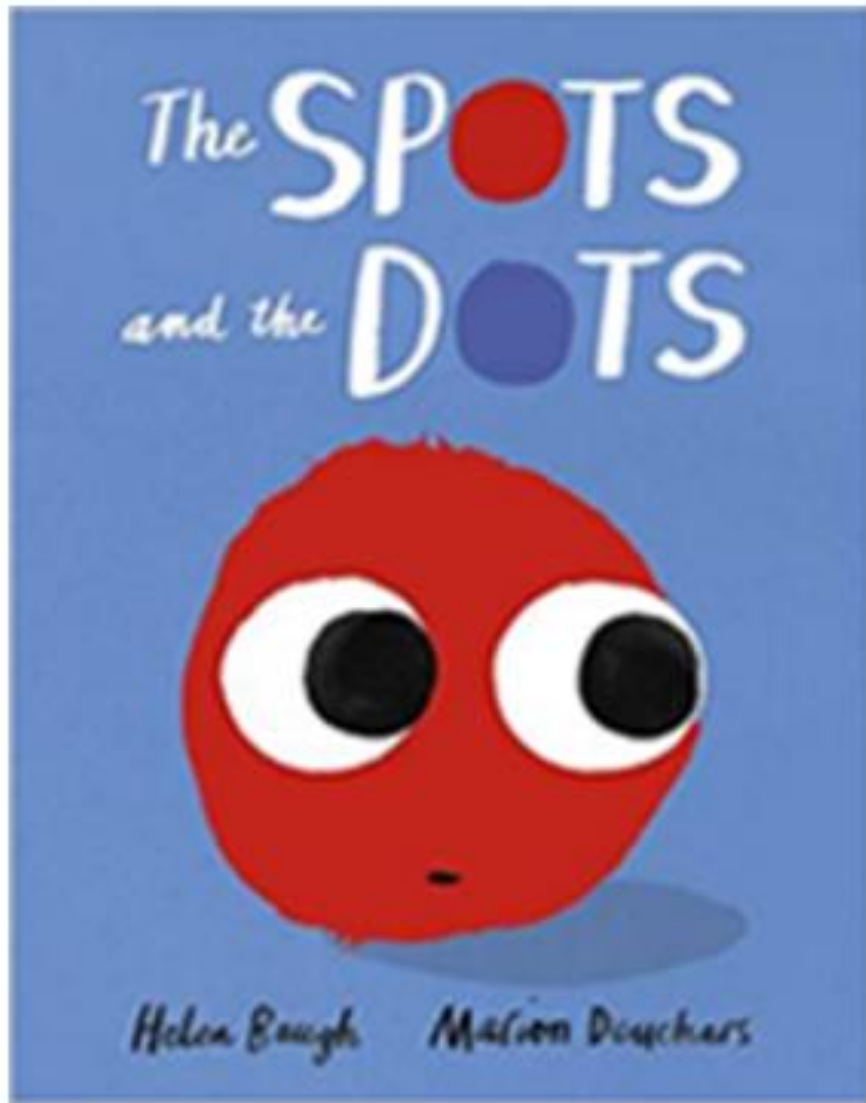
# Fear of the unknown

# Prejudice

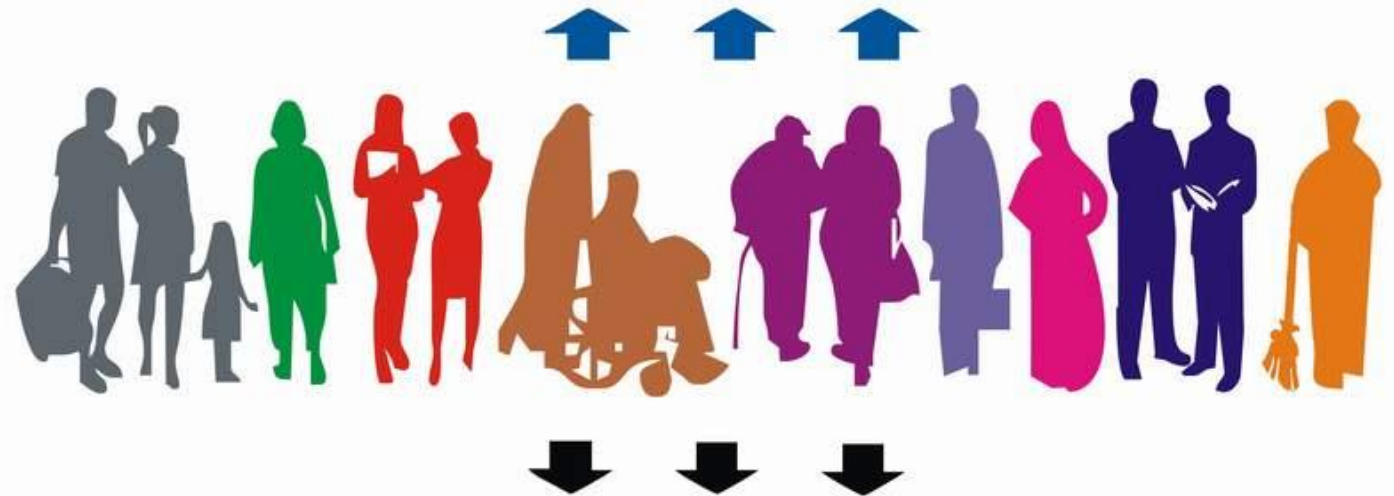
Prejudice refers to prejudgment before knowing facts. It usually refers to unfavorable prejudgments toward people or groups.
