As a member of the School Council, I agree to represent my class and school respectfully, responsibly and fairly. I understand that being a School Councillor is an important role and that I have been chosen to help share pupil voice, listen to others and support positive changes across the school.

I agree to:

- **Attend School Council meetings** whenever possible and arrive on time.
- **Listen carefully** to the views and ideas of other pupils and adults.
- **Represent my class fairly**, not just my own opinions or the opinions of my friends.
- **Share ideas respectfully**, even when people have different opinions.
- **Follow the school values and rules** during meetings and around school.
- **Speak politely and kindly** to everyone.
- **Take turns to talk** and allow others to contribute.
- **Keep discussions sensible and focused** on how we can improve our school.
- **Share information with my class** after meetings when asked to do so.
- **Ask my class for their ideas** before meetings when needed.
- **Be honest and trustworthy** in my role.
- **Respect confidentiality** if a member of staff says something should not be shared.
- **Help with School Council projects**, events or responsibilities when I can.
- **Be a positive role model** for other pupils.

I understand that the School Council is a place where pupils can share ideas, raise suggestions and help make our school even better. I know that not every idea will be possible, but all ideas should be listened to and considered fairly.

I also understand that if I do not follow this agreement, an adult may speak to me about my role and help me improve. If I continue not to follow the agreement, I may be asked to step down from the School Council so that another pupil can take on the responsibility.
