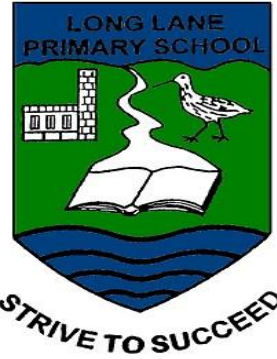

# what safeguarding rules do we have in school?

---

- Permission for taking and displaying photo's
- Firewalls on the computers and internet
- Strict rules about using technology under supervision
- No phones or video, photo or calling devices in school



# What are we keeping you safe online from in school?

- Improper use of photographs
- Cyber bullying or pressure
- Being scammed
- Seeing adult content that may offend, upset or confuse you
- Opportunities for you to be taken advantage of
- Teaching you to be a good 'online' citizen



# Use of photography in school

---

We cannot use phones or smart watches to take pictures in school.

- Some children are not allowed photos taken of them (this is consented by parents, it may put them in danger)
- Nobody should have a photo taken of them without their consent (and because they are minors, without their parents consent)
- A photo could be used to tease, humiliate or bully another child
- Some children don't have these devices and may feel this is not fair (always think of the feelings of others)



# Use of technical devices in school

---

No use of technical devices in school –that are not registered to the school

- these cannot be regulated
- We can't control where the photos will end up (and this could be the school's responsibility)
- You may be distracted with yours and others learning

If you are in contact with other adults or children outside school (when inside school)

- You may get upset or anxious and we won't be able to help you
- You may say something that causes your parents to be worried unnecessarily
- You may be talking to a stranger and we would need to monitor this (school have too many children to do this)

# Why the school has its own rules!

---

- When children come to school the staff are in 'loco parentas'. This means that while you are in school, we keep you safe and take care of your welfare
- The school has its own rules – these follow a strict safeguarding policy
- These rules might be different to the rules in each of your homes because the school is not the same and has to look after all sorts of different children with different backgrounds and experiences



# What happens if there is an emergency at home or at school?

---

If there is an emergency at school – the school will always let your parents know!

If there is an emergency at home - your parents/carers will choose whether to inform the school or wait to tell you when you get home!

**THESE RULES ARE REALLY IMPORTANT!**

If you are contacted and told some bad news but the adults at school don't know about it, they won't know why you are upset, anxious or shocked

If you contact your parents and tell them something worrying, then this will cause them to worry unnecessarily

**THE ADULTS (STAFF AND PARENTS) ARE WORKING TOGETHER TO KEEP YOU SAFE AND HAPPY**
