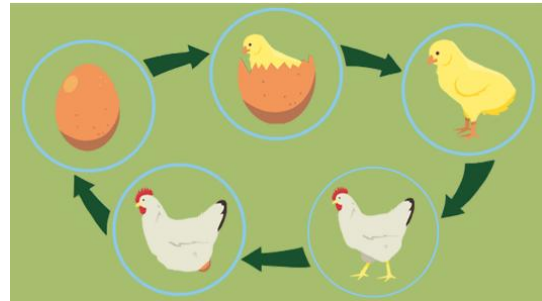


Summer 2

In **Geography** we will be looking at our local Geography and mapping skills.



Our **PSHE** theme is: Changing Me.

We will be looking at life cycles of frogs, butterflies and humans. We will name and label different parts of male and female bodies.

As **writers** we will continue to learn how to join our writing. We will develop our writing skills by using different text types.

As **readers** we will continue to learn and consolidate sounds following RWI. We will practise reading to develop fluency and expression.

In **DT** we will be learning about structures and buildings.

In **computing** we will practice typing (digital writing) and grouping data.

As **scientists** we will:

- identify, name, describe and compare a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- identify and name a variety of animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Identify vertebrates and invertebrates.

We will start to think about moving to year 2. We will have story swaps, play times and spend time in our new classroom.

As **historians** we will explore our local history.

As **musicians** we will explore different genres of music.

In **RE** we will learn about Rosh Hashannah and Yom Kippur.

As **athletes** we will:

As **mathematicians** we will learn about money, fractions and positional language. We will look at the four operations, numbers and place value.
